Stewardship Prayer

LORD, YOU ARE THE GIVER OF ALL. MAY THE WAY I GIVE BE AN EXPRESSION OF MY LOVE FOR YOU, MY DESIRE TO IMITATE THE GIFT OF YOUR SON, JESUS. HELP ME TO DISCERN WHAT I TRULY NEED, YOUR LOVE AND YOUR GRACE, AND TO PUT ALL I HAVE IN SERVICE TO YOU. I ASK THIS THROUGH CHRIST, OUR LORD.

Everything we have is a gift from God. Since ancient times, people have expressed their gratitude to God by giving the "first fruits" back to God. Setting aside the first part of the harvest for God was an expression of their faith that all comes from God.

We no longer measure our income by bushels of grain and goats but the principle remains the same: giving back to God the first portion of our income as an expression of gratitude for all that God has given us.

This worksheet is to help you and your household assess your level of giving now and make plans for the future. On the other side is a table to help calculate giving on a weekly, monthly, and yearly plan based on your income and the percentage you choose to give.

How much should we give? The particular percentage of our income that we give is a matter of prayer and discernment for each household. A standard that has been used for centuries is 10%. Many Christian thinkers in the area of stewardship recommend that we give five percent to our parish through the offertory collection, one percent to the diocese/greater church and four percent to other charities that serve the poor and needy and support the common good. Your particular percent may be more or less than that standard. The key is that it represents your first fruits, giving first to God as recognition that all comes from God. Holding to that percent will require discipline, perseverance, a willingness to say no to some of our wants, and trust that God will provide what we most need.
